Information Note for Invited Participants

Date and Time

The OCP Round Table will take place on both 5 and 6 June 2019 from 13.00 to 14.30 (two 90-minute sessions).

Location/Venue

The OCP Round Table will be held at the Palexpo in conjunction with the <u>Meteorological</u> <u>Technology World Expo 2019</u>. The Round Table will take place in **Halle 3 - Salle W**, next to the exhibition hall, as shown in the floorplan shown in Appendix A to this note. WMO staff will be on hand to help guide attendees to the area.

Transportation

CICG - Palexpo

<u>For those attending the Congress-18</u>, dedicated buses will be located outside the International Conference Centre Geneva (CICG) for transportation to Palexpo. The buses will display signs noting "OCP Round Table – Invited Attendees". While bus space is limited, it is understood that some invited attendees will be accompanied by additional staff. It is kindly requested that the limit on additional staff is held to one person per invited attendee, barring exceptional circumstances. **The buses will depart at 12.10**, **sharp.** For additional staff that cannot be accommodated on the dedicated buses, there will be regular bus service from CICG to Palexpo for all Congress attendees.

For those coming directly from the airport or from elsewhere, the Palexpo site has additional information on transportation, parking, etc.

Palexpo – CICG

Similar to the transportation from CICG to Palexpo, dedicated buses will be available to return participants to CICG. The same guidance on maximum capacity and additional staff apply just as they did for transportation to the venue. **The return buses will depart at 14.40, sharp.**


Lunch/Reception
